
FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

Courageous Connections offered more classes in 2019 than the year prior. We were able to use a grant we received late in 2018 to fund \$2,000 in scholarship expenses in 2019.

We also had a very successful year-end fundraising event which is not included in our financials as most of the funds posted in January 2020. That said, those funds are providing a good strong financial start to 2020.
