DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

There is no doubt 2020 has left a mark on each and everyone of us. It is a year we will all talk about for years and years to come. Yes it has been marked by tragedy and at the same time it was marked by courage and hope.

The uncertainty and stress all around us confirmed Equine Assisted Learning and therapy is a much needed service. It provides a path to healing from trauma, anxiety and stress. After classes were suspended in September due to COVID, we received approval to operate as an essential service in Sept 2020 and immediately resumed our Equine Encounters program.

A break in our adaptive riding classes caused a big shift in volunteerism. We focused on increasing our business volunteers to tackle some important tasks, while we continued to wait for a full return to our in-person programs. We had almost 60% fewer volunteers, yet our business volunteers worked diligently, totaling almost the same number of volunteer hours we had in 2019. These business volunteers are a diverse group stretched across three time zones. We are humbled by how many share their valuable time and skills to further the mission of Courageous Connections. We thank you.

We enter 2021 with financial strength due in large part to the generous grants by School's Out Washington and Tulalip Tribes, plus the generous contributions of individual donors and others. Program revenue was down by 44% and related program expenses down by 52%. Business expenses were also down by 30%. This all due to the suspension of classes for so many months.

We are excited about what the future holds and to ensure we can provide services to as many people as possible.




FINANCIAL OVERVIEW


Courageous Connections offered more Equine Encounters classes in 2020 than 2019. The health department granted 'essential service' status in September allowing us to provide unmounted classes.


A grant by School's Out Washington for \$10,000 received in Q4 significantly impacted cash on hand and will ensure fiscal security into 2021. Funds from 2019 Tulalip Tribes grant was received in 2020. The Glaser Foundation has also provided a grant and funds are expected in early 2021.


Below find comparative charts showing 2019 to 2020 for revenue and expenses. Comprehensive financial statements are shown on page 6.


